- January and February Meeting Minutes approved. Darlene moved and Tracey seconded – both motions passed unanimously
- Public Comment:

Tresse DeLorenzo, of Executive Director of Kidzart gave an overview of her program which includes Art classes for children from 2 years old thru 9<sup>th</sup> grade. She gave all in attendance an informational package with the specific classes available thru her program and she was looking for our support to get facilities to offer these programs to the children in town. Typical Classes to cost \$75.00 and \$60.00 for Mommy and Me per 6 week session. The possibility of fee to recreation converted to savings on enrollment was discussed.

- **Summer Rec** – Counselor applications to be accepted in May with interviews to begin in June. Alternative locations were discussed as Summer Recreation will likely be displaced by renovations. Harbor was rejected due to traffic and safety concerns. The idea of putting a tent up at Firemans Field was discussed as well as using the Elementary School.
