WHY RECYCLE?

- **It has economic and environmental benefits.** All this "stuff" no longer goes into landfills. As much as possible, it's remanufactured into new products - glass reshaped, newspapers remade as paper; plastic drink containers become lumber. Recycling saves resources and raw materials.
- **It costs you nothing.** Atlantic Highlands recycles about 8,000 tons, or about 4 tons per household, on average, every year. It is now costing the Borough money to recycle since all markets are in decline, but it saves the Borough dumping fees at the County Landfill.
- **It's the law.** Violators are subject to penalties, including fine, jail and/or community service. It's a violation if you put recyclables in with regular garbage. At the County Reclamation Center all garbage is dumped on the floor and if they find recycling the Borough gets fined.

Code Enforcement plays an important role in preserving the attractive appearance of neighborhoods in the Borough of Atlantic Highlands. The mission of Code Enforcement is to provide fair and comprehensive enforcement of Borough Codes, which include junk, debris, trash, nuisance, weeds, brush and rental/leased property maintenance.

The Borough of Atlantic Highlands encourages its citizens to become community minded. You are encouraged to get to know your neighborhood and meet your neighbors. Working together we can provide and maintain safe, clean and attractive neighborhoods.

Citizens are also encouraged to cooperate with one another in a friendly manner to resolve minor concerns before contacting Code Enforcement for assistance.

If there is a violation of the Borough Ordinances, the violator is warned of the violation and given a reasonable amount of time to correct it. If the violation is not corrected, a summons can be issued, which will result in a municipal court appearance.

SNOW REMOVAL

Borough code requires any owner or owners of every lot, tract or parcel of land fronting on any street, highway or public place in the Borough shall remove snow or ice within 24 hours after the termination of the resulting precipitation causing the same.

That the owner or owners of every lot, tract or parcel of land fronting on any street, highway or public place within the limits of the Borough of Atlantic Highlands shall, within 24 hours after the termination of a precipitation causing the sidewalk or that part of the public way reserved for pedestrian traffic in front of said lot, tract or parcel of land fronting on any street, highway or public place in said Borough to be covered with snow or ice, remove, or cause to be removed, such snow or ice. Ice which is so frozen as to make removal impractical shall either be treated with rock salt or other chemicals which will thaw it sufficiently to permit removal or be thoroughly covered with sand, ashes or cinders.

BOROUGH CODE 300-14

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

PURPOSE:

To establish requirements for the proper handling of yard waste in the Borough of Atlantic Highlands, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for the failure to comply.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION:

Sweeping, raking, blowing or otherwise placing yard waste that is not containerized, at the curb or along the street is only allowed during the five (5) days prior to a scheduled and announced collection, **and shall not be placed closer than 10 feet from any storm drain inlet.** Placement of such yard waste at the curb or along the street at any other time or in any other manner is a violation of this ordinance. Brush collection consists of TREE **PARTS** ONLY. Brush mixed with roots, leaves, grass, lumber or oversized material WILL NOT BE PICKED UP! [This is not a tree removal service]. Brush must be stacked parallel to the curb in front of YOUR dwelling not to extend more than three feet from the curb.

Brush and leaves will be picked up during these periods ONLY! Please make sure that all leaves and brush are put at the curb, ready for pick up, by 7:30 am on the Monday of the FIRST pick-up day for your zone. There will only be one pick up, in your area, during your scheduled week. If you miss your zone's pick up, you may not put leaves out until 5 days prior to your next scheduled pick-up. Trucks do not circle back for further pick-ups.

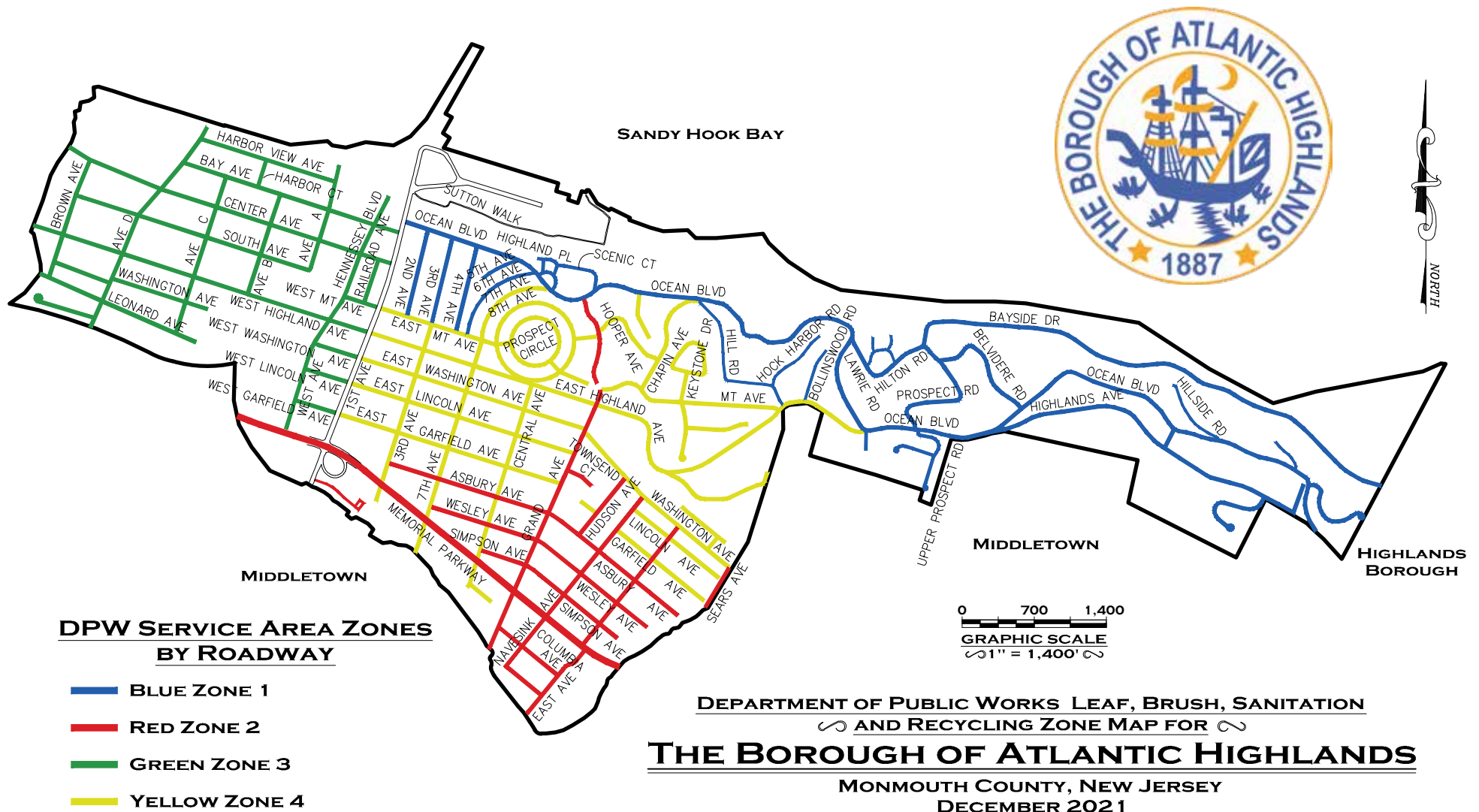
